


INFRASTRUCTURE BILL













STEP ONE: INTRODUCE A CARBON TAX, ON BUSINESS PRODUCING AN EXCESS AMOUNT OF CO2, ALONG WITH AN INCREASED ALLOCATION FOR INFRASTRUCTURE FROM THESE TAXES, WILL DIRECTLY FUND THE INFRASTRUCTURE ACT.

STEP TWO: WORKING WITH MDOT AND INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS, MICHIGAN WILL BE TURNED INTO A GRID OF 8 EVEN GRID SQUARES.

STEP THREE: WITH THE DIRECTION OF MDOT, THEY WILL ENSURE THAT EVERY ROAD IN EACH GRID IS UP TO THE STANDARD SET. ANY THAT DON'T MEET THE STANDARD SET WILL BE REPAVED AND REPAIRED TO FIT THAT STANDARD.

STEP FOUR: EACH GRID WILL TAKE NO LONGER THAN 6 MONTHS TO COMPLETE. FINES AND POSSIBLE LOSS OF FUNDING WILL BE THE PENALTY FOR NOT COMPLETING ON TIME.

STEP FIVE: A BIPARTISAN COMMITTEE WILL WATCH OVER AND ENSURE THE CONTRACTS ARE COMPLETED QUICKLY AND ACCURATELY.

> **ESTIMATED TIME TO COMPLETE: 4 YEARS ESTIMATED COST: 5 BILLION DOLLARS**
